- ✓ In-depth knowledge of relevant EU strategies, policies and policy & market instruments and experience working on methods such as (EU) **policy evaluations, Impact Assessments, cost-benefit analyses, indicators development, scenario building**;
- ✓ Quantitative capabilities (advanced Excel skills, statistical analysis, etc.) and modelling skills are a plus;
- ✓ Interest to work on a wide range of EU environmental policy issues within these domains is essential;
- ✓ Ability to work, write and communicate fluently in English. The ability to work in additional languages is considered an advantage.
